What is alcohol harm?

The under belly

In the 3 month period studied:

- 1500 students had unprotected sex
- 760 had a sexual situation they were unhappy with
- 2000 had a sexual encounter they regretted

In a four week period studied

- 363 had an unwanted sexual advance
- 93 were sexually assaulted

Facts

In NZ there are over:

- 7000 on-licences
- 3000 off-licences
- 1500 club licences
- 42,000 manager certificates

Cost of:

- Alcohol harm = \$9.1 billion
- Illicit drug harm = \$1.9 billion

Income from:

- Alcohol excise tax = \$1.3 billion (used for general government spending)
- Alcohol levy = \$16.6 million (to recover the cost health incurs addressing alcohol-related harm and other alcohol-related activities)

Harm from alcohol:

- More than 2 deaths per day
- Contributes to over 200 health conditions, including at least 7 cancers
- A factor in 30% of all fatal crashes

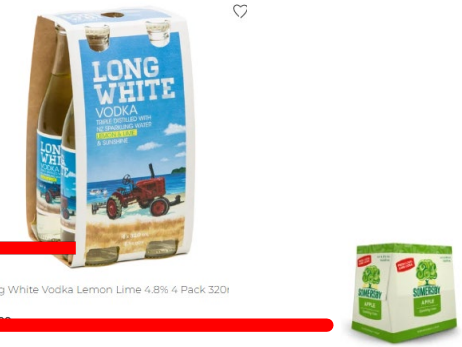
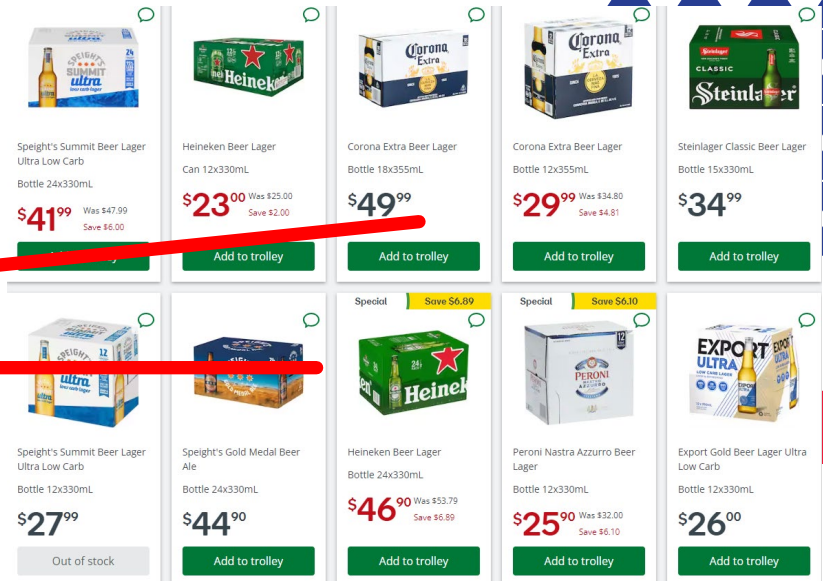

Alcohol Action Plan

The Big 5 – Te Rima Nui

Hours	Reduce off-licence hours to between 9am and 9pm and on-licence hours to 8am to 2am.
Single sales	No single serve sales to be sold for less than \$6 (amount to be revised for inflation at renewal).
Remote sales	Anyone facilitating the sale of alcohol to be licensed. Licensees to be liable for the actions of third party deliverers. Prohibit the rapid delivery of alcohol.
Density	Prevent increasing the density of off-licensed premises, particularly in areas with high deprivation index scores and within Māori communities. Prevent off-licences from existing near sensitive sites such as schools and marae.
Screening and brief intervention	Implement screening and brief intervention (including referral to support services) for those that frontline interact with who may have alcohol use issues.

Legislation changes

Anzac Day, Easter- passed

SASA (Improving Alcohol Regulation) Ammendment

- Clubs can hold an on-licence
 - What does this look like?
- Restaurants can have an off-licence
- Barbers/ Hair-dressers can supply alcohol
- Cellar door taskings extended
- Televised events
